Year 6

ART: Wildlife Birds

This 'Wildlife' themed lesson pack will teach your class about how to use pencil, white pencil, print, make clay tiles and model to create quality art work that shows progression in skills.

North American Art

This 'North American Art' unit will teach your class about how to draw the other half of a famous image, make collage landscapes, create body abstracts, make 'building block' houses, draw patterned skulls and be an artist's model to create quality artwork that shows progression in skills



Geography: Our Changing World

Children will discover some of the many ways in which the world around them is changing, from coastal erosion to political changes. Pupils will learn about the structure of the United Kingdom and how its shape and geography have changed over thousands of years.

History: World War II

This unit of work will teach your class all about World War II.

They will learn when and why World War II began and find out about the key individuals and countries involved.

Science: Animals including Humans

Children will build on their knowledge and understanding of different systems within the body. They will research the parts and functions of the circulatory system.

Light:

Recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines. Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye.

PSHE: A Diverse Britain

This unit is inspired by the idea that Britain represents a wide range of faiths and ethnicities and that the structures within it are there to support all.

Be Yourself

This unit is inspired by the idea that we are all individuals and that it is important to 'be yourself'. It aims to encourage the children to develop a positive view of themselves and enable them to recognise the importance of being proud of their individuality

PE: Invasion Games

Pupils will develop fundamental movement skills, become increasingly competent and confident with their own motor skills. They should be able to engage in a range of competitive and cooperative physical activities, in a range of increasingly challenging situations.

Computing: SCRATCH Animation

The unit is designed to help children in continuing to develop their skills in writing their own algorithms as well as editing and debugging existing codes.
