

YEAR ONE AUTUMN TERM CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

PE- Multi Skills and Throwing & Catching. They will learn how to move in a variety of ways using different parts of their body. They will also focus on spatial awareness so they understand the importance of moving safely in a space. They will also learn how to balance on different parts of their body.



Mathematics- We will be covering a variety of topics involving number, shape and space, data handling, measures, and problem solving. It would be a great help over the next few weeks if you could practise number bonds to 10, doubles & halves and practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s with your child.



ICT- Word Processing Skills & Online Safety. We will focus on basic keyboard and mouse skills, such as turning on and switching off the computer. The children will also be using Microsoft Word to type sentences and save work.



English-In the Autumn Term, we will develop our speaking and listening skills by talking about stories in familiar settings. Children will also create alphabetically ordered lists of different items as part of information texts. Focus on reading poems aloud and create their own repetitive poems.

Geography- Children will be learning about the local area. They will get the opportunity to walk around the school and identify different locations.

History - Children will learn about the history of travel and transport and how this has evolved over the years.

Science-

Materials- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

Art & Design- Making a salad. Children will be tasting different fruits and vegetables. They will also develop vocabulary to describe the appearance, taste, smell and texture safely.
